New Beginnings New Orleans Retreat Hosted by Yeye Luisah Teish and Queen Leia Lewis October 30 – November 3, 2019

I. Retreat Overview

(A) RETREAT ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE

Please plan to arrive the morning/afternoon of October 30 or October 31.

We will access the New Orleans Retreat House property starting at 3 PM on October 30.

Please plan to depart late afternoon/evening of November 3.

We will depart the New Orleans Retreat House property at 11 AM on November 3.

Of course, you may extend your stay in New Orleans by securing your own hotel/lodging.

(B) WISDOM TEACHING, RITUALS & SACRED SITES EXPERIENCES

Please see the attached schedule of activities. This schedule is subject to unannounced changes. There also will be time allowed for you to explore New Orleans on your own.

(C) TRAVEL TO/FROM NEW ORLEANS

You are responsible for coordinating and paying your travel expenses to/from New Orleans. If you are buying an airline ticket, then you are encouraged to choose travel insurance when booking. You also can reach New Orleans via car, bus, and train. Please do your research and make appropriate plans. You are responsible for coordinating and paying for your ground transportation to/from the airport or bus station to the local housing or hotel where you are staying.

(D) NEW ORLEANS RETREAT HOUSE

We are making arrangements for group housing at a local residence, Air BNB in Uptown New Orleans. The focus is providing a safe, neat, comfortable environment for the group. We are not focused on providing luxury accommodations. Our research shows that the housing will accommodate 11 registered women. The shared housing cost is \$250 per woman. These funds will be pooled together to cover the housing rental. The spaces for staying at the New Orleans retreat house will be filled on a first come basis via completing your registration payment for the retreat. Please also see the budget for full details of the retreat investment.

(E) OVERFLOW LODGING & HOTEL

Because the New Orleans house will have limited capacity, some women may need to or prefer to stay at a hotel. We can support women communicating to coordinate plans for sharing hotel rooms by utilizing the private Facebook group. Any woman who stays at hotel (or other lodging) is responsible for making arrangements and paying this expense on her own.

(F) LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

We will travel around the city as a group with shared Uber or Lyft. Please be prepared to budget and bring \$100 for this purpose. As much as possible, these funds will be pooled together for transportation in the city for women staying together at the New Orleans retreat house and/or other lodging.

(G) LOCAL MEALS

Community prepared meals and the feast will be prepared and shared together. Please be prepared to budget and bring \$150 for this purpose. These funds will be pooled together for our shared meals and the feast. Also, we will have some meals at restaurants. There is amazing food and drink in New Orleans! You are responsible for buying your own meals + tipping at any eateries we visit together or on your own. You will need bring ADDITIONAL funds for this purpose.

It is possible that we will make changes to the retreat schedule and actual activities; and we reserve the right to make unannounced changes in order to provide you a quality retreat experience.

ARRIVE NEW ORLEANS - Wednesday, October 30

<u>Arrive in New Orleans</u>. Settle in Bed and Breakfast. Build group altar: All participants gather for a first meal at the house. We are renting a house to be together. Some women may elect to stay at a hotel. <u>Later in the evening</u>, <u>we will gather for late night wisdom sharing and playshop to make spiritual potions and powders</u> with Queen Leia Lewis-Iya Oriade.

Thursday, October 31

Attend the Voodoo Festival on Dumaine Street in front of Voodoo Authentica. Presenters will include: Mambo Marie (NOLA), Mambo Maggie from New York (Mama Lola's House). Pere Francois of Mississippi. Nana Sula (Akan priestess) and Yeye Luisah Teish. Music and Food. This street festival is often full. Yeye presents at 4 pm but we will arrive early to secure our seats. Dinner at a French Quarter Restaurant. No entry fee. Donation to drummers. Yeye's students also will visit the cemetery of Voodoo Queen Marie Laveau pending our ability to secure an official licensed tour guide whose services we prefer.

Friday, November 1

All Saints Day Parade at the Backstreet Cultural Museum. Led by Rachel Bruelin from the University of New Orleans Story Project. Yeye Teish's students will participate in building the altar for this event, will tour the Museum, march in the parade, and may also attend the exhibit at the Cabildo on San Malo maroon settlements. You may purchase an early copy of Le Ker Creole a textbook on the Creole language of Louisiana. This is especially good for those pursuing the paths to Voudou and/or Hoodoo. This event includes a photographic exhibit of the Wild Mushrooms of the Louisiana Bayous. May also include a few short films about the Congo and some materials from the Healing Arts concert. This is a full day of activity. **Recommended donation \$21.00 or more.**

Later this evening, Yeye, students, and special guests celebrate the Wild Women Feast of Oya.

Saturday, November 2

Enjoy your morning on your own exploring New Orleans.

Then later in the day, we will gather for the evening ritual that is a Voodou Ceremony at the peristyle in Pas Christian, Mississippi. Fete for Ghede is the Haitian ritual tradition of honoring the Ancestors. We will coordinate round-trip ground transportation for the group to have this same-day excursion and ritual experience.

DEPART NEW ORLEANS - Sunday, November 3

Ritual Day at Ile Coin-Coin. Ile Coin-coin is directed by Nana Sula. We begin with a lesson in the art of Water-gazing. Participants are asked to bring a clear glass (preferably a chalice/wineglass), a white candle, pen and paper, and to wear white clothing. Yeye Teish will teach the art of water-gazing as a way to quiet the "monkey mind"; to enhance intuition in an "Alpha state", and as means of communicating with kind spirits to receive guidance through imagery. Then Iya Omotinubua Fayemi will assist the participants in creating artworks in fabric and feathers (as in the tradition of the Black Indians of La.)

We will break for a vegetarian meal will be served at Ile Coin-Coin. Then, we will fulfill a group Money Pouring Ritual before the Shrine House in Nana Sula's garden. Yeye Teish will discuss the Powers of Aje, the Yoruba Goddess of Wealth. Participants are asked to bring an object for the altar that symbolizes wealth, coins to contribute to the pouring bowl, a sacred oil (available for sale from Nana Sula), and a lidded jar with which to take some of the Money Pouring water to their home altars. Yeye Teish will provide the Roses of Jericho for the ritual.

Also happening this day (timing permitting) is community drumming and dancing in the historic Congo Square. Meet other community members and priests interested in Voodoo and Hoodoo of New Orleans. **Donation to drummers.**

GUEST CANCELLATION POLICY

If you cancel your Retreat/trip, Yeye Luisah Teish and Queen Leia Lewis do not offer refunds for any reason. To cancel your retreat payment and retreat participation means that you are forfeiting your entire payments made to date. We will gladly transfer your payment credit minus a \$100 administration fee. Any person registering for this Retreat is to be a natal-woman. In the event of transferring your space to another woman, this this guest's complete name and contact information must be communicated within 15 days before the retreat. Exceptions to our cancellation policy cannot be made for any reason. We do not offer credit for a guest arriving late or leaving early.

You must submit your signed Participant Agreement form within one week of booking and securing your space with registration online and/or offline. Guests who fail to do so may be subject to an automatic cancellation and the above policy will apply. This form will be provided within 72 hours or your registration paid in full or paid deposit.

TRAVEL

You are responsible for booking and purchasing your personal round-trip airfare to and from New Orleans. While travel insurance is not required, we suggest that you research the benefits of purchasing trip cancellation insurance independently, on your own, and with a insure of your choice. Depending on the policy and conditions, travel cancellation insurance will pay for some or all cancellation fees. With most agencies, insurance must be purchased within 14 days of making your reservation.

ROOMMATES

The standard retreat housing is shared rooms in a group house. We will assign your bed assignment and roommate on first come, first to register basis.

RETREAT PREPARATIONS

After your registration, we will provide you additional information to prepare for the retreat, including Tips to Plan Your Travel, What to Wear, and What to Bring. This information will be sent to your email address and/or communicated through our Facebook Group.

CHANGES & CANCELLATION

It is possible that we will make changes to the retreat schedule and actual activities; and we reserve the right to make unannounced changes in order to provide you a quality retreat experience. While it is highly unlikely, if Yeye Luisah Teish and Queen Leia must cancel the retreat date for any reason, then you may transfer your full retreat payment to another retreat, or you may request a refund of your payment in writing. Your refund shall be paid within 90 days and constitute a full settlement.
